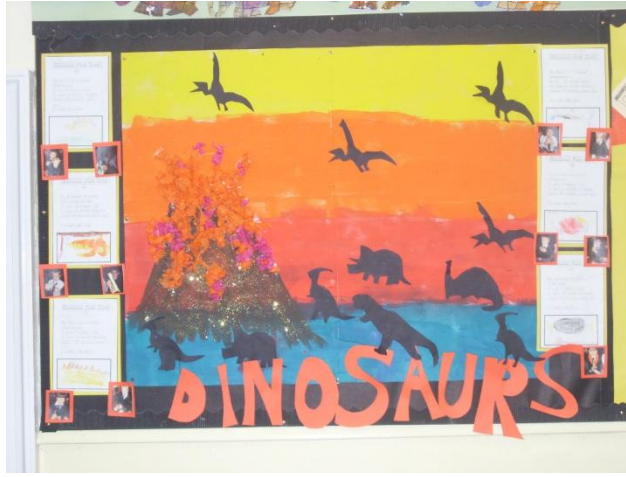

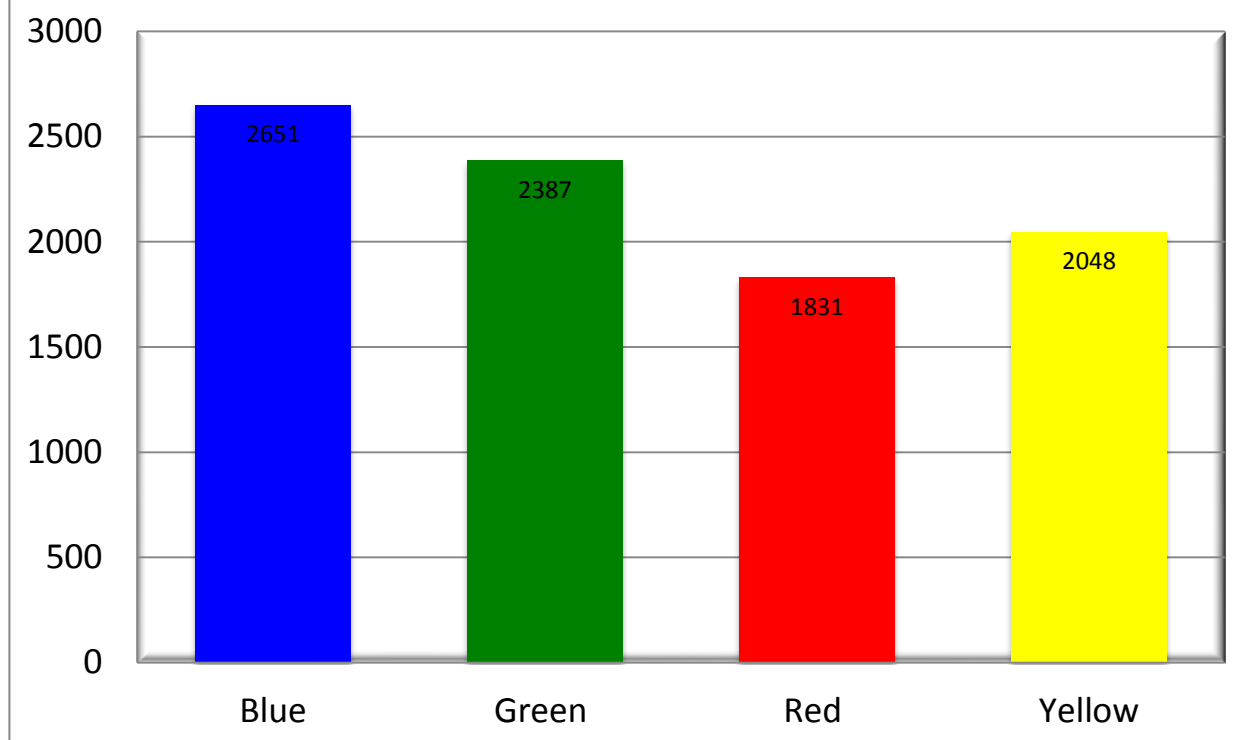
LKG made a Dinosaur display this week, following on from their talk last week from Mad Professor Firoozye!
