BESPOKE TEACHING PROGRAMMES


























































PLAY WITH PASSION

There are also opportunities for boys to experience other sports including fencing, rock climbing, judo and futsal


Each term, there is a full programme of inter-school and inter-house fixtures, which allows every boy in the school the opportunity to develop his sporting skills




THE INTEGRITY OF THE GAME IS EVERYTHING
