Scholarships and exhibitions were awarded across a range of subjects including Academic, Art, Sport, Music and Choral. These scholarships included the Brighton College 11+ Millennium Scholarship (in Art, Sport and Choral) and a Music Exhibition to St Paul's Girls' School, together with 4 Scholarships to JAGS in Academic, Music and Sport, and many more.

Visitors always comment on the calm, quiet and happy atmosphere of the school and it is this underlying feeling of warmth and inclusivity that supports the girls' learning and underpins the examination results that the girls achieve.

In the classrooms you will see girls really enjoying their lessons, and in the adventure

playgrounds or on the Common they will be having fun and letting off steam full of verve and fizz! It is all part of a rounded experience that makes Eaton House The Manor Girls' School so special.

OVERVIEW

"The atmosphere in the girls' school is extremely warm and friendly. Pupils call the teachers by their first names, prefixed by their title – it's both respectful and familiar and reflects the school's overall vibe...Lessons we observed seemed formal but relaxed, with girls encouraged to think, work things out and express themselves... Pupils we spoke to said they enjoyed daily 'thinking questions' where they are asked to talk about topical issues."

ACADEMICS

"It's an academic school with impressive outcomes, but it is non-selective and mixed-ability so parents stress it does not have a hothouse atmosphere. Parents say they have been 'impressed by recent additions of experienced teaching staff'. They say that although the school has girls reaching an 'incredibly high' academic standard, others are not left behind and are encouraged to develop their talents wherever they lie."
